HOWEVER, DUE TO AN UNFORTUNATE INCIDENT DURING THE RECORDING OF ONE OF THE LAST TRACKS IN THEIR ALBUM, THE DANIELS TALCUM PARTNERSHIP WAS TERMINATED.
